



## DURHAM COUNTY SENIOR LADIES' GOLF ASSOCIATION

### Club Representative's Role

- Membership is open to ladies who have reached their 50<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- A new member can join immediately on or after her 50<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- Fees are £5 for full members and £2 for associate members, who are not eligible to play in competitions or to vote.
- Joining members must have a Handicap Index of 40 or less

#### **The Role / Duties:**

1. Collect the annual membership fee from your Club's Members together with their up to date details, i.e. Name, address, email, contact number and emergency contact number.
2. The fees and details should be sent to the Seniors' Treasurer by 1<sup>st</sup> December each year.
3. Encourage new members to join throughout the year.
4. At the Seniors' AGM, collect an information pack for your club containing:-
  - a. A list of members for updating.
  - b. Fixture lists for the following year.
  - c. Posters and Competition entry sheets to display at your club.
  - d. Tickets and Posters for the Coffee Morning to sell and display at your club.

#### **Competitions:**

Advertise the Seniors' competitions in your club and encourage members to enter.

1. Collect entries and fees. Payment on the day will not be accepted.
2. Send **entries** to the Competition Secretary before the closing date.
3. Send **entry fees** to the Treasurer before the closing date. Payment by BACS or cheque – A reference name and club will be required for both options.
4. Check website for information, starting times and results and inform your members.
5. BUGGIES. May be used by players with a medical condition, but permission is required from the Seniors' Secretary in advance of the day.

**Members are responsible for booking their buggy and insurance.**

#### **Teams:**

- Durham Seniors Bronze Team  
The Bronze team play Cumbria and Northumberland in six 4BBB matches for the Team Shields. 20 Players with the best Gross scores in the Bronze Spring Meeting will form the Bronze Squad for selection.
- Durham Seniors Silver Team  
The Silver Team play against the other 5 Northern counties for The Richardson Trophy. Teams play 7 singles matches off scratch.
